

2018 Lincolnshire Windmills Photo Competition

This competition is open to all and will be judged

Cash prizes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each category

Competition Criteria

There will be two categories – Adult (Over 18) & Youth (17 & under)

Please complete the entry form detailing where and when the image was taken and also please add details to the reverse of the print.

The windmills can be fully or semi operational, under renovation, renovated or derelict. Wind turbines are excluded.

Entries can be submitted from the 1st March to the 30th June 2018 and will be judged by a nominated panel of judges.

The winners will be announced at our exhibition on 1st September.

Rules:-

- 1. Entrants can enter up to four images as prints in landscape format.
- 2. Your photographs must be taken in Lincolnshire between the 1st Jan 2017 and the 30th June 2018.
- 3. All entries must be the sole work of the photographer and unpublished at the time of submission.
- 4. All entries must be in a printed format to a maximum size of A4. Landscape images only. Entries should <u>not</u> be mounted or framed. Email entries not accepted.
- 5. All prints must have the full name and address of the photographer, if 18 and under please indicate age written on the reverse of each entry.
- 6. Closing date for entries is Saturday 30th June 2018
- 7. The judges will be nominated by The Market House Photography Group and the decision of the judges will be final.
- 8. Copyright of images will remain with the photographer. However entry into the Competition will permit credited use of entrants photos by the Market House Photography Group for promotional purposes, if required.
- 9. Photographers should obtain permission from any identifiable people in their compositions prior to entering the picture into the competition.
- 10. Only one prize per entrant
